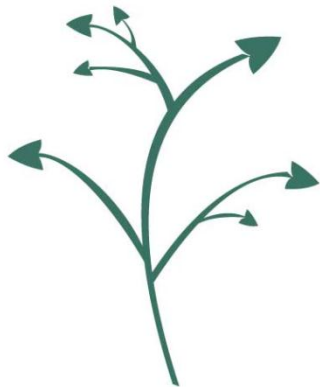


Assessment Policy Enhancements

including Randomisation options



learnPro™

Overview

The learnPro Assessment Editor is part of learnPro's Authoring Suite. It allows you to create new or edit existing assessments – including setting policies for how the questions and answers are displayed.

What is new?

- You now have additional Assessment Policy options to set at Board/Trust level for an individual module or assessment that your organisation has created
- Users can start an assessment from where they left off if they accidentally close the browser during an assessment

1. What do the new Assessment Policy options do?


The new options available to you when creating or editing assessments are as follows.

(NB these will be switched off for any existing assessments you have on the system. However, if you enable them, they will do the following):

- *'Randomise the Question Order'* will display the assessment questions in a different order every time the assessment is taken.
- *'Randomise the Answer Order'* will display the multiple choice answers the questions in a different order each time.
- *'Stop if Content is Accessed'* will detect if the user is browsing any module material on the learnPro system and halt the assessment attempt.
- *'Use Banking'* allows you to ask the user a random selection of questions from the assessment.

2. How do I set the Assessment Policy for assessments belonging to my organisation?

1. To start editing assessments for your users, go to Authoring -> Assessment Editor on the top menu.
2. On the Assessment List page, next to the assessment you wish to randomise click 'Edit'. The new options will appear as below:

3. Check or uncheck the randomisation settings as required.
4. If you select to Use Banking, use the 'Number of Questions to Use' box below this to enter the number of questions you would like the user to be asked – these will be randomly selected from the questions you have entered. Please note that this setting will be ignored if you enter 0 or a number greater than the number of questions provided in the assessment.
5. Once you are happy with the settings click 'Update'
