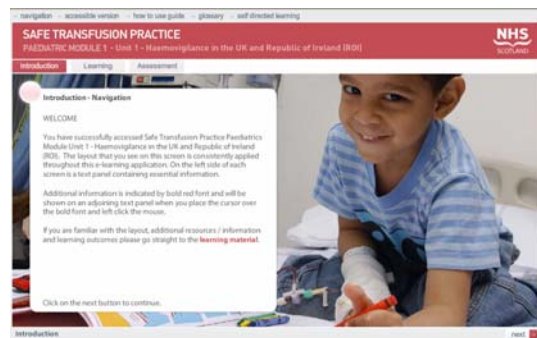
A version of *Module 1 Safe Transfusion Practice* has been developed for staff working in the paediatric setting and is now available at

Who is the module intended for?

*Module 1 Safe Transfusion Practice in the Paediatric Setting will become the minimum requirement for staff within this field of practice.*

- 1. If you have already completed the standard Module 1 Safe Transfusion Practice your current learning record will remain valid for a two year period.*
- 2. When you are required to revalidate your training you should then undertake the new Module 1 Safe Transfusion Practice in the Paediatric Setting rather than the standard Module 1.*
- 3. Any previous learning that you have undertaken will be retained.*



The content follows the same themes as the standard Module 1 but in addition, it highlights the specific requirements of paediatric patients, particularly neonates and infants requiring transfusion, addressing

- Consent for transfusion
- Blood sampling for pre-transfusion testing
- Precautions that need to be taken in the identification of children and neonates
- Monitoring of children and neonates having transfusion
- Prescribing blood volumes in terms of mL/kg body weight.
